## *Expressing Regrets*

Example Sentence	Meaning	Possible Result
He should have locked his car.	Locking the car was an obligation. It was the right thing to do.	?
I should have told her the truth.	?	She doesn't know the truth.
We shouldn't have lent him that money.	?	He ran away to Las Vegas without paying back.
She ought to have studied more.	Studying was a good idea but she didn't do it. She made a mistake.	?
?	I carried the box, and now I'm sorry.	My back hurts now.
?	Giving Jane a map was the right thing to do, but I didn't and I'm sorry.	Jane got lost.
It was a lovely old building. They shouldn't have knocked it down.	?	There is a shopping center in place of the old building now.

Example Sentence	Meaning	Possible Result
He didn't need to buy some food.	?	He came home without any food.
He needn't have bought any food.	?	He had a fight with his wife about putting the extra food in the fridge.
?	I didn't get up early, but I could if wanted to.	I stayed in bed.
I needn't have got up so early.	?	I waited a long time for the bus.
?	You rushed, but you could have taken your time. I was not necessary to rush.	You are exhausted now.
He was very famous. He didn't need to carry his luggage.	?	His bodyguard carried his luggage for him.

<u>Sorry, I ought to have given Jane a map.</u>	Giving Jane a map was the right thing to do, but I didn't and I'm sorry.	Jane got lost.
It was a lovely old building. They shouldn't have knocked it down.	<u>They knocked down the old building.</u>	There is a shopping center in place of the old building now.
<u>They shouldn't have spent so much time playing computer games.</u>	It was a bad idea but they still played computer games a lot.	They are repeating the same grade this year.

Example Sentence	Meaning	Possible Result
He didn't need to buy some food.	<u>He didn't buy any food as it wasn't necessary.</u>	He came home without any food.
He needn't have bought any food.	<u>He bought food but it wasn't necessary.</u>	He had a fight with his wife about putting the extra food in the fridge.
<u>I didn't need to get up early.</u>	I didn't get up early, but I could if wanted to.	I stayed in bed.
I needn't have got up so early.	<u>I got up so early.</u>	I waited a long time for the bus.
<u>You needn't have rushed.</u>	You rushed, but you could have taken your time. I was not necessary to rush.	You are exhausted.
He was very famous. He didn't need to carry his luggage.	<u>He didn't carry his luggage.</u>	His bodyguard carried his luggage for him.
